Invitation for Pre-Qualification

- Republished due to update of Threshold Requirements and Submission Date -

Tender for design, drilling, testing and equipping of drinking water wells including procurement and installation of pumping stations

1. General

- 1.1 Mekorot Water Company Ltd. (“**Mekorot**”), the national water company of the State of Israel, is an Israeli government owned company. Mekorot is responsible, inter-alia, for drilling, equipping and operating wells for the production of potable water.
- 1.2 Mekorot hereby invites local and foreign corporations, companies, or partnerships, including joint ventures (“**Participants**”) to participate in the pre-qualification process for providing the following services to Mekorot: design, drilling, testing and equipping of drinking water wells including procurement and installation of pumping stations for Mekorot (“**Scope of Work**”), all in accordance with the provisions of the Pre-Qualification documents (the “**PQ Documents**”).
- 1.3 It is expected that the Eligible Participants will compete under the Tender Process for two work packages (each package, a “**Project**”), each to include 38 or 39 facilities as described in the table below:

- 1.4 Mekorot intends to select one Successful Bidder to execute each of the Projects, a total of two Successful Bidders, through the following stages:
 - 1.4.1 the PQ Process; and subsequently,
 - 1.4.2 a Tender Process with respect the Projects, as shall be determined by Mekorot.
- 1.5 The purpose of the Pre-Qualification process (the “**PQ Process**”) is to identify Eligible Participants, who will be invited to participate in the Tender Process for the Projects.
- 1.6 A Successful Bidder which is awarded a Project, may also be awarded, from time to time, additional work (in relation to design, drilling, testing and equipping of drinking water wells including procurement and installation of pumping stations) which is not part of the awarded Project, based on the needs of Mekorot.
- 1.7 Unless otherwise defined in this notice, all terms used in this notice shall have the meaning ascribed to such terms in the PQ Documents. The information provided in this notice, including (but not limited to) with respect to the PQ Threshold Requirements, is partial and for informational purposes only. Accordingly, Participants are obliged to review the PQ Documents in their entirety and to comply with all of the provisions of the PQ Documents. In the event of any discrepancy between the content of this notice and the content of the PQ Documents, the PQ Documents shall prevail.
- 1.8 Participants should note that the Tender Process is conducted in accordance with the Government Procurement Agreement (GPA) with the World Trade Organization.

2. Access to Documents

- 2.1 Any Participant wishing to participate in the PQ Process is requested to register in order to receive a link to the Sourcing Vision System (“**Sourcing Vision**”) by sending an e-mail to Mrs. Hadas Keren hkeren@mekorot.co.il with a complete Schedule 4 of the PQ Documents (*Sourcing Vision Registration Form*) attached to the email (which such Schedule 4 includes the following details: Participant's name, first and last name of the Representative, address, postal code, telephone, mobile phone, email address and (if applicable) corporate registration number). Upon registration, an e-mail will be sent to the Participants, containing a user name, password and a link to access the Sourcing Vision system, including a copy of the PQ Documents. Messages and clarifications, if any, will also be sent to the Participant's e-mail submitted in the Sourcing Vision system.
